CONGRESSMAN JIM MORAN CONTINUING "PAY-TO-PLAY" SCHEME TRADING GOVERNMENT FUNDS FOR CAR & CAMPAIGN CONTRIBUTIONS

(Arlington, VA) - The Matthew Berry for Congress campaign has released an analysis showing that Jim Moran received over \$40,000 in campaign contributions in the fourth quarter of 2009 from executives, PACs, and lobbyists of companies for which he has requested earmarks totaling \$39.5 million. Such donations represent over twenty-five percent of the money raised in the fourth quarter by Moran and bring his total for all of 2009 to over \$120,000 received from these sources.

Moreover, Moran's latest fundraising report suggests that those benefiting from his earmarks requests are paying for his use of a luxury automobile. Specifically, Moran's campaign funds are being spent on an automobile lease of \$786 a month, car insurance payments, personal property tax payments, and automotive repairs. All in all, Moran's campaign spent over \$5,000 in car-related expenses during the fourth quarter of 2009.

When asked for comment, Kristopher Morris, Campaign Manager for Matthew Berry for Congress, made the following statement:

"Jim Moran's latest campaign finance report shows that he continues to be knee-deep in a 'pay-to-play' culture that one would expect to find in Rod Blagojevich's Illinois. And, it appears as though Jim Moran may be personally benefiting from these corrupt contributions. We should all be asking Jim Moran what type of car his campaign is leasing for over \$750 a month and whether the Congressman is using that car for personal transportation."
